SUBJECT: Consider Revisions to Originally Adopted Master Plan for Southeast Gustine Annexation

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

In March, 2018 the City considered and approved a Master Plan for the Southeast Gustine Area. Exhibit A depicts the adopted circulation concept and a conceptual layout based on lots of minimum 6,000 square feet. The area was then taken to LAFCO and annexed into the City.

City staff has been in discussion with the original proponents of the Master Plan area regarding two potential changes to the Master Plan. Proposed revisions are illustrated in Exhibit B (this exhibit depicts proposed lotting patterns only for the Katakis and Rasmussen properties as those are the areas currently in active consideration).

One is a revision to the internal street pattern to allow for the main access to Sullivan Rd. to align with Grove St. This would allow for installation of a roundabout at that intersection. Additionally, the easternmost street access shown on the current plan would be revised to eliminate the direct connection and allow for emergency vehicle access only. These revisions result in a less direct path through the internal part of the plan area. Overall, staff recommends that the proposed pattern is preferable in that the roundabout at Sullivan and Grove is a better solution for that intersection and removes closely spaced offset intersections. Further, the conversion of the easternmost intersection to emergency-only reduces conflicting movements near the school.

A second change would be to allow for a wider range of lot sizes with up to 10% of minimum 5,000 square foot lots and the balance remaining as minimum 6,000 square feet lots. This necessitates a minor change to the design guidelines to provide for the smaller lots. Staff suggests that this change provides an increased range of opportunity for housing type and is well within the acceptable range of lot size for single-family homes.

Staff is bringing these concepts to the Commission, and later to Council, for review to determine their acceptability before entertaining applications for tentative subdivision maps and a minor amendment to the Master Plan.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to the City.


RECOMMENDATION



Conceptual Site Plan






VICINITY MAP
