What does the Planning Commission do?

The Commission:

- ▲ Studies issues related to the development of the community and makes recommendations to the City Council.
- ▲ Helps formulate and amend the General Plan. The General Plan is a guide that sketches out all the important details needed to create a thriving, well-balanced community.
- ▲ Makes decisions on zoning and land use by acting as the reviewing body for zoning variances and conditional use permits.
- ▲ Reviews and recommends subdivisions and neighborhood development plans.



ALREADY OVER-COMMITTED?

Meetings are held once a month, often less. Special meetings may be called when an urgent item or special project arises.
Once appointed, Planning Commissioners serve four-year terms. Currently one seat is available.
